### PUSH TO TALK (PTT)

#### Initialize the Push To Talk Service

1. From the **Home screen**, press the **PTT** key on the left side of the device.
2. A screen will appear asking if you want to initialize PTT. Press the **Left Soft** key to select **Yes**.
3. You will be asked to register a name in the PTT system. Enter a name (up to 20 characters) and press the **Left Soft** key to select **OK**.
4. A screen will flash to inform you that the process of Initialization has begun. Initialization can take several minutes. When the process is complete, a screen will appear to notify you that PTT is ready for use. An icon will appear below the time indicator on the your Home Screen.

#### Add a Push To Talk Contact

After initializing PTT, you must add individuals or groups to your PTT contact list before you can place a PTT call. Individuals and group members must subscribe to the AT&T PTT service.

1. From the **Home screen**, press the **Menu > Push to Talk (PTT) > Add Contact**.
2. Enter the new contact's name and phone number.
3. Press the **Left Soft** key to select **OK** when you are done.
3. The phone will now send the invitation to your new contact. You will see an icon while the invitation is in progress.

#### Make a Push To Talk Call

1. With the phone open or closed, press the **PTT** key located on the left side of the device.
2. The **PTT Contacts screen** will appear (when device is closed, it can be seen on the outside screen). Use the **Navigation** keys (when device is closed, use the Volume Up/Down key) to highlight the contact you would like to reach.
3. Press and hold the **PTT** key to establish a connection.
4. A moment later, you will hear a beep.
5. Hold the **PTT** key down while speaking and release it when you are not.
6. To end a PTT session, press the **End** key.

Note: You will be automatically disconnected if the call has no activity for 30 seconds.

### AUDIENCE™ NOISE REDUCTION

#### Turn on Audience™ Noise Reduction

Audience™ Noise Reduction will be disabled if speakerphone, PTT, wired headset or Bluetooth headset is used. To re-enable in a call press **Options** and then **Noise Reduction On**.

## CALLS AND VOICE MAIL

### Make a Call

1. From the **Home screen**, press the **SEND** key to access the recent calls screen OR enter the phone number by using the numeric keys on the keyboard.
2. Press the **SEND** key.
3. To end the call, press the **END** key.

Note: To activate speakerphone, press the **CENTER NAVIGATION** key. To place a call on hold, press the **Left soft key** to select **Options > Hold**.

### Answer a Call

1. Press the **SEND** key.
2. Press the **END** key or close the phone to end the call.

### Check Voicemail

1. Press and hold the **1** key.
2. Follow the voice prompts.

## ADD AND ACCESS CONTACTS

### Add a Contact

1. From the **Home screen**, press **Menu > Address Book > Add a Contact**.
2. Enter in Name and Number
3. Select **Options > Save**.

## PERSONALIZE THE DEVICE

### Change the Ringtone

1. From the **Home screen**, press **Menu > Settings > Sound Profile**.
2. Select one of the available options (Normal, Silent, Driving or Outdoor) and press the **Edit** soft key to access the sound settings.
3. Press the **Change** soft key to change a particular setting.
4. Select one of the Call Alert Type options and press **Select**.
5. Press the **Save** soft key when you are finished.

### Shop for Ringtones

1. From the **Home screen**, press **Menu > AppCenter > Ringtones**.
2. Select an entry.
3. Follow the on-screen instructions to purchase a ringtone.

## USE TEXT MESSAGING

### Send a Text/Multimedia Message

1. From the **Home screen**, press **Menu > Messaging > Create Message**.
2. Type a message.
3. Press the **Right Soft** key to select **Send To**.
4. Press the **Right Soft** key to select **Send**.

Note: To add or attach an item to the message, press the **CENTER NAVIGATION** key to select Insert. Select the item to attach. Choose the desired item from the list.

## USE THE CAMERA

### Take and Send a Picture

1. From the **Home screen**, press **Menu > My Stuff > Tools > Camera**.
2. Press the **CENTER NAVIGATION** key to take a picture. The camera may take a moment to focus before the picture is taken.
3. After the picture has been taken, press the **Left Soft** key to enter the Menu, and select **Send > Via Message**.
4. Type a message (optional).
5. Select **Send To**.
6. Type a phone number or you can select an entry in your saved contact list.
7. Press the **Right soft key** to **Send**.

Note: Pictures will be automatically saved in Pictures in the My Stuff folder.

## AT&T NAVIGATOR

1. Press the **GPS** key.
2. Select a pricing option; for this example, press **Go** to select the 30 days free trial.
3. Read the warning, then press **AGREE**.
4. Select an option; for this example, scroll **DOWN** to No, Skip Tour, and press the **CONFIRM** key.
5. To exit the application, press **EXIT** from the AT&T Navigator home page, then press **YES**.
6. You will receive text message confirming your activation. Press View and note down the PIN.
7. Press the **POWER/EXIT** key to lose the message and exit.
8. To access the AT&T Navigator press the **GPS** key.
9. Press **YES** to agree to the Terms of Use.
10. Press **GO** to begin your 30 day free trial or select **Try a Day Pass** for \$2.90.
11. Note: If you do not cancel within 30 days you will automatically be charged \$9.99 a month.
12. Read the Warning, then press **AGREE** to continue.
13. Select **Yes** to take a brief tour of AT&T Navigator. Here, scroll **DOWN** to No, Skip Tour and press the **Select** key.
14. To Exit, press **EXIT**, then press **YES**.

## SET UP BLUETOOTH®

### Activate Bluetooth®

1. From the **Home screen**, press **Menu > Settings > Connectivity > Bluetooth**.
2. If the first item in the Bluetooth menu is **Bluetooth : Off**, then highlight the **Bluetooth : Off** option by pressing the **CENTER NAVIGATION** key.
3. The **Bluetooth activated** confirmation prompt displays on your device.
4. If the first item in the Bluetooth menu is **Bluetooth : On**, then Bluetooth is already activated.



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
